Whilst this Club has a moral and statutory duty to take all reasonable steps to ensure the general welfare and protection of children and vulnerable adult members, in particular during the actual act of model aircraft flying and associated pre-flight and post-flight procedures, the Club will not undertake the all encompassing responsibilities of those acting in the role of guardians or carers.

It is your responsibility to ensure the well being of your charge and should you wish to leave a child or a vulnerable adult at the flying site or any other club activity, it is your responsibility to appoint a responsible adult to supervise your charge at all times when they are at the flying site or engaged in any other activity organised by the club such as club meetings. This includes having knowledge of any particular medical requirements and providing or arranging transport to and from the flying site. The club makes no recommendations of suitable persons to be appointed as a responsible adult.

By signing below you acknowledge and understand that minor physical contact may be required during model flying instruction and that agree that such contact may take place.

Should the Club wish to use a photographic image of your child; the Club will follow the guidelines laid down by the NSPCC Child Protection in Sport Unit detailed in the BMFA policy. No photograph will be used without the written consent of the parent or guardian.

In addition the BMFA and this Club have specific rules and policies relating to children and vulnerable adults which are available from the respective websites or from the club secretary or Welfare Officer.

You should note that the club does not provide toilet facilities at its flying site and it is your responsibility to make suitable arrangements.
